CLUBS AND SOCIETIES

Cringleford Parish Council

Cringleford Parish Council is committed to fostering a "single vibrant, caring and safe community in which all residents feel comfortable, at home and valued" (Cringleford Neighbourhood Development plan, 2013, 5.1).

To this end the Parish Council:-

- 1. Will not only support existing clubs and societies in the Parish but will also encourage the establishment of new ones.
- 2. Will undertake to make its facilities available to clubs, societies and other organisations based in the parish. It will seek to maintain them to an appropriate standard.
- 3. Will make the facilities available for hire primarily by organisations based within the parish or which are for the benefit of the parish or a large number of parishioners, who will normally be given priority in booking. Organisations from outside the parish may hire the facilities when they are not being used by parish based organisations.
- 4. Will not seek to make a profit from hirings but will seek to cover a reasonable part of its costs (including staff time, materials, water, lighting, heating, replacement and refurbishment). Any surplus profit made will be reinvested into facilities for the good of the parish.
