5.1 2022/1913, Land West of Round House Way - Erection of 40 units together with garaging and associated access and infrastructure. Objection. TW to draft

response and circulate to Councillors for agreement.

- 5.2 2022/1886, 3 Gurney Lane Single storey and two storey extensions with revised pool-house structure. No objection
- 5.3 FUL/2022/0044, Cringleford Primary School, off Colney Lane Proposed two storey 420 place Primary School including related standalone substation and related works, standalone switchroom and related works, car parking for staff and visitors (59 spaces including disabled spaces and EV charging spaces) and external hard and soft surfaced outdoor play areas. No objection in principle but would submit issues to Planning regarding lack of drop off area for parents. TW to write draft for circulation

- 6.1 Big Sky (St Giles Park). The new link road from the development to Cantley Lane had been opened. The former gate across Cantley Lane had been removed, with bollards installed in their place.
- 6.2 Tilia Homes (Roundhouse Gate). No update other than the planning application at 5.1.
- 6.3 Barratt David Wilson Homes / Crest Nicholson (Cringleford Heights). The orchard would be planted on 12 and 13 December by staff, The Conservation Volunteers, and volunteers from the developers.

7. To receive an update on the forthcoming sports hall and agree actions where necessary

TW advised that meetings to consider internal aspects of the building had been held with developers and the nursery to detail the room data sheets. Completion of the building had been moved back to April 2024. Finally, a meeting had been held with InstaVolt, who had offered an attractive package for EV charge points to be installed onsite.

- 9.1 Big Sky Cantley Lane lighting. Following the decision that the streetlights on the closed part of Cantley Lane would not be repaired as the cost would be £26k, Big Sky had offered to remove the redundant streetlights for no charge. It was agreed that this offer be accepted. **Action Clerk**
- 9.2 National Highways A11 Spooner Row to Tuttles Interchange reconstruction scheme update meeting details circulated.
- 9.3 A47 A11 Thickthorn Junction update the plans had received consent and should start in 2024, subject to a potential judicial review.
