Keswick, Low Road/B1113 Mulbarton Road – Drainage Improvements

Work will begin on or shortly after Monday 7 January 2019, to carry out essential drainage improvement works on Low Road/B1113 Mulbarton Road in Keswick. It is anticipated that this work will take approximately 6 weeks to complete, subject to suitable weather conditions.

Low Road will be closed for traffic during construction for a period of 4 weeks from 7 January. The closure will be between its junction with Mulbarton Road and Keswick Hall Road. Diversion route will be in place via Mulbarton Road, Ipswich Road, Daniels Road, Newmarket Road, Colney Lane and Keswick Road, which will be signed clearly during work period. Work on the B1113 Mulbarton Road will be conducted under 3 way traffic lights.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during works.

The County Council thanks people for their patience while this drainage improvement work is carried out. The work which will cost £65,000 (approx.) will be carried out by Norfolk County Council's Community and Environmental Services Department and their contractors.
