

# BECOME A PARISH COUNCILLOR – MAKE A DIFFERENCE IN YOUR COMMUNITY!


Cringleford Parish Council is looking to co-opt four parish councillors.

To become a councillor, you must satisfy the following criteria on the day you are co-opted: be at least 18 years of age; be a British citizen, a qualifying citizen of a Commonwealth country, a citizen of the Irish Republic, or a citizen of another member state of the European Union
