The Intwood Road/Colney Lane parking consultation held by Norfolk County Council at the Willow Centre on the 26th September 2019 was discussed by Councillors. It was agreed that the Clerk would collate the residents' responses to create a synopsis of issues identified with Norfolk County Council's proposed plans for future reference.

8.1 Big Sky (St Giles Park) – the Parish Council was notified that Big Sky had received the planning consents required to start on site and that works had begun on Monday 30th September 2019.

10.2 Newmarket Road West Slip Road – in response to Norfolk County Council's reply regarding additional 20mph signs for Newmarket Road, Councillors agreed that the Clerk should contact Cllr David Bills and ask that he contact Cllr Brian Watkins (Norwich Eaton) to explain the Parish Council's suggestion of additional signage and the response that had been received from Norfolk County Council.

discussed the location of the additional bus stop on Roundhouse Way that had been previously agreed by Norfolk County Council, and how the amended plans would affect this. Cllr T Wang agreed to draft a response to the application, reinforcing the comments submitted by the police regarding additional boundary hedging, whilst also requesting the addition of a pathway from the bus stop to the Barratt David Wilson Homes borderline to help create permeability between the two developments. This would be circulated to Councillors for approval.
